

WAITING LIST CLOSED

The Section 8 waiting list is not currently open. WHA does not have an anticipated reopening date, and applications from the general public cannot be accepted while the list is closed.

KEEP YOUR INFORMATION UPDATED

REPORT CHANGES IN WRITING WITHIN 10 DAYS

Report changes to your **mailing address, income, preference, or family composition**. WHA sends selection notices by U.S. mail, so keeping your address current is essential.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

If I was one of the first people to apply, will I receive a voucher first?	Not necessarily. Selection is based on WHA's waiting-list preferences, not simply the order in which applications were received.
How long will it take to receive a voucher?	WHA cannot provide a time frame. Voucher issuance depends on funding, voucher availability, preferences, and other program factors.
How will I receive updates about my application status?	WHA will contact you by U.S. mail when your application is selected for an eligibility determination. Because staff cannot provide estimated selection dates or routine status updates by phone, please keep your mailing address current to ensure you receive all notices.

OTHER PROGRAMS & COMMUNITY RESOURCES

HUD-VASH: Veterans experiencing homelessness—begin with the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs.

FUP/FYI: Eligible families and youth—referrals through the public child welfare agency.

HOPWA: Eligible households affected by HIV/AIDS—contact a HOPWA provider or medical case manager.

EHV: WHA is not accepting new referrals.
